The Closing Eucharistic Liturgy will take place on Saturday afternoon, July 28, at 3:45 PM in Bellarmine Chapel.

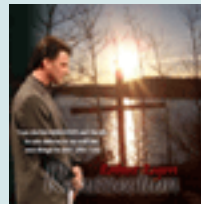
A SPECIAL EVENING IN REMEMBRANCE OF FATHER AL LAUER

FATHER MITCH PACWA, S.J. is an esteemed Catholic teacher and evangelist, who is nationally known for his television and radio programs on EWTN as well as for his many books, tapes, and speaking engagements. He is a learned Bible scholar and a captivating teacher of the faith.

Father Mitch Pacwa, S.J. received his B.A. in Philosophy and Theology from the University of Detroit, summa cum laude. He received his Master of Divinity and S.T.B. from the Jesuit School of Theology of Loyola University, magna cum laude.



He was ordained a Catholic priest in 1976 and then continued his studies, receiving a Ph.D. in Old Testament from Vanderbilt University in 1984.



He has taught at the High School, University and Seminary levels. He has lectured at conferences and churches around the world and has appeared and hosted hundreds of international radio and television programs. His fluency in twelve languages including Biblical languages, Arabic, and European languages and his ex-

tensive travels throughout the Middle East have afforded him a unique understanding of the peoples and cultures of the Middle East. In the year 2000, he established Ignatius Productions in order to further promote the gospel through multi-media teaching presentations. He teaches through books, DVD's, and other media.

FATHER AL LAUER, the founder and spiritual leader of Presentation Ministries spent his lifetime in service and self-sacrifice for Jesus and His Church.



We, at Presentation Ministries, do not want to lose sight of the tremendous contribution Father Al made to us and to countless others. At his inspiration and direction, many ministries were initiated and are flourishing today.

Father Al experienced a great renewal by the Holy Spirit in the second year of his priesthood and that was the key to his very effective ministry. He began teaching the Bible and could see the powerful way that the Holy Spirit worked through the Word.

In addition to radio broadcasts, Father Al trained lay people to be Bible teachers, ministers of healing, intercessors, and leaders of ministries and small Christian communities.

He was the originator and long-time author of *ONE BREAD, ONE BODY* as well as numerous other books and pamphlets. His teachings are also available on audio and video cassettes.

The Bible Institute was founded by Father Al to provide teaching for equipping the laity. His vision was to raise up lay people as disciples of Jesus. He charged us to accept Christ's call to live a simple lifestyle in order to spread the gospel.

Father Al was received into his heavenly home on October 13, 2002. We know that, even now, he along with many others in Presentation who have departed this life are a great "cloud of witnesses" (Heb 12:1) who are praying for us and this ministry.

DISCOVERING YOUR SPIRITUAL GIFTS

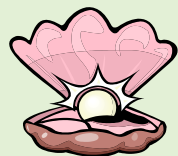

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

XAVIER UNIVERSITY

The Bible Institute is held on the campus of Xavier University, which is centrally located in the Cincinnati area. A map of the campus will be sent with the acknowledgement of your registration. Please allow two to four weeks for our response. Parking permits **will NOT be required** to park in the Xavier campus parking lots this year.

HOUSING

Housing in Xavier Residence Halls is **limited** this year because of two other large conferences being held on campus. The rooms are air conditioned and will be assigned first come, first served with out of town registrants being given preference. Double occupancy is usually assigned although a very limited number of single rooms may be available. Registrations for housing must be in by **June 30**. Other options for housing include nearby hotels, motels, and other off-site locations.

When you arrive, stop first at the Registration Desk to get your room assignments, keys, etc. **Please note:** The Registration Desk will be located in the Hailstone Building (previously Williams Business College or CBA Building). A map of the campus will be sent with the acknowledgement of your registration.

MEALS

Xavier Food Service will offer some meals in the Dining Room. Lunch will be available each day from Saturday, July 21 through Saturday, July 28 at \$6.70. Dinner will be available on the evenings indicated at \$9.25 each. WEST: McMillan to Victory Parkway, left on Victory Parkway to Dana, right on Dana to Ledgewood, left onto Ledgewood.

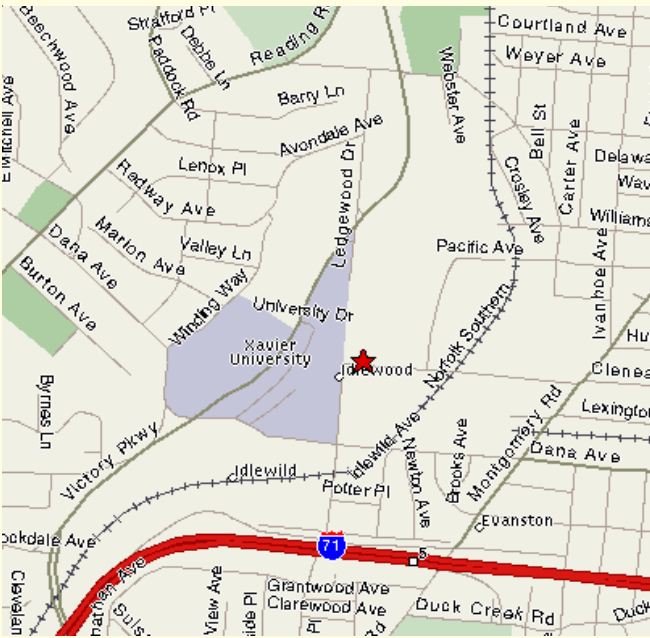
NORTH: From I-71 take Dana exit. Go right (west) onto Dana to Ledgewood, right onto Ledgewood.
