FEATURED GUESTS



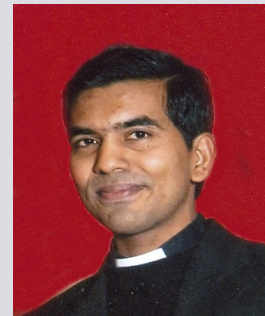

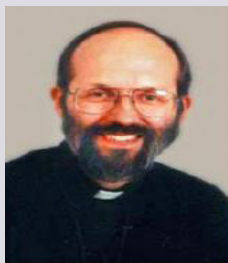

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Pre-registration, by July 3rd, is required for housing and meals. Registration for weekday classes can occur up to the day of the class. Some classes fill up quickly so it may be best to register early. Incomplete registration forms will delay your processing.

EACH SEMINAR HAS 4 SESSIONS PER DAY WHICH LAST FROM 9:00 AM TO 4:45 PM, WITH BREAKS FOR LITURGY AND LUNCH.

In order to process your registration, we need all the information at one time. Availability is assigned in the order that the COMPLETED form is received. You will receive a confirmation via e-mail if registration is done online. Registration sent by mail, will receive confirmation by mail. Allow time for it to be processed. Registration after July 10 will not be confirmed by mail.

Information will be available at the registration desk upon your arrival with all needed materials. Class outlines and other general information materials are available at the registration desk. Bring your acknowledgement materials with you. On Sunday, July 26 the registration desk will be in Fenwick Place. Starting Monday, the registration desk will be located in Alter Hall.

MEALS

Meals are offered at the Fenwick Dining Room which is a state-of-the-art dining facility on the first floor of Fenwick Place. **All meals must be pre-ordered through the registration form by July 3rd.** They have a variety of dishes to suit many different appetites and food allergies.

Please see meal order on registration form for days that meals are available in dining hall. Other possibilities for meals are restaurants on nearby Montgomery Road or take out delivery options. **The Food Court on the lower level of Gallagher Student Center has fewer options on the Weekend. The cafeteria meals and off-campus restaurants are another option to purchase meals.**

Complete all the appropriate areas on the registration form through EVENTBRITE using a credit card. Cell phone number must be included. Registration form in brochure may be mailed if preferred. **ALL MEALS MUST BE PRE-ORDERED AND PAID IN ADVANCE BY JULY 3 – NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE AFTER JULY 3RD.**

HOUSING INFORMATION

THIS YEAR housing on campus in Fenwick Place begins on Saturday July 25th or Sunday July 26th. A registration desk will be located in the lobby from 3pm until 9pm on Saturday and 12 noon until 9pm on Sunday. We require a \$100 non-refundable deposit for each person or couple registering for housing. If you wish to share a room or suite with someone, please send in your registrations together or indicate on the registration form in the appropriate area. **Registration deadline is July 3rd.** There are hotels nearby if you prefer to lodge off campus.

If you need to cancel or change the date of your arrival on your registration **or plan to arrive past 9 pm** on Saturday or Sunday or past 7:30pm through the week, **YOU MUST CALL** 513-207-0905 to notify the volunteer who awaits your arrival.

If you are arriving other than times posted **YOU MUST** make arrangements to stay elsewhere until the following morning. There is no one available to accept your arrival and sign in at other times. All references to time are Eastern Daylight Time. Please be considerate of our staff!

The building has air-conditioned suites that include a common living area and 3 or 4 bedrooms with shared bathrooms. Most bedrooms are double occupancy with very few single rooms available. There are microwaves and refrigerators in nearby lounges.

Weekday seminars will be located in Alter Hall across the green space from Fenwick Place. All locations are within walking distance. Golf carts will be available for shuttling those in need of assistance.
